After much deliberation and counsel, the right decision is to postpone both our much-anticipated March 20th *Fete for 50* celebration as well as our 8th grade trip to Washington, D.C. at the end of this month. There are a multitude of reasons why it was the hard but right decision, but none more compelling than simply keeping safe those we most love and value, from students to friends, families, and supporters of St. George's.

We are also looking closely at other activities, events, and field trips on our calendar, considering them case by case, that would congregate larger crowds and prove difficult to employ the public social distancing practices recommended by the New Orleans Health Department.

We have already reserved the venue and intend to put on an event worthy of St. George's Episcopal School and you.

COVID-19 will not be invited this time, though. Let's hope it stays that way and stays away. Be well.
